PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 324 and 506(ii) IPC, in Crime No.71 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to wordy quarrel, the petitioner assaulted the de-facto complainant and made criminal intimidation against him. On complaint, a case has been registered against the petitioners.

3.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and prays for bail in favour of the petitioner.

4.It is submitted by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) that the injured is still in the Hospital.

5.Even though the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that the injured is still in hospital, it appears that the nature of injury is not serious, which would not result in



alteration of the FIR.

6. Taking note of the above said facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kamuthi, Ramanathapuram District, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
