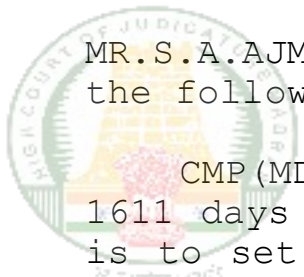

The Petitioners filed a petition before the trial Court in I.A.86 of 2011 in O.S.No.86 of 2010 on the file of the District Munsif Court, Ramanathapuram to impleaded themselves as party in the suit and that petition was dismissed.
