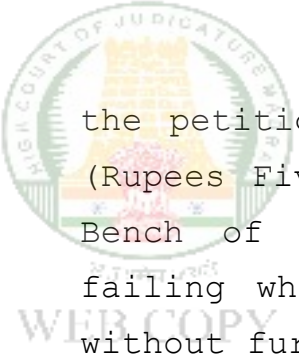
PRAYER IN CRP(MD) No.SR27974 of 2015:
