Prayer in CMP(MD). 3180/ 2018 :

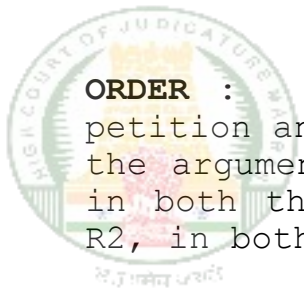
Pleased to condone the delay of 3704 days in preferring the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal and thus render justice.

ORDER : These petitions coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.G.S.ASOK ADHITHYAN, Advocate for the petitioner in both the petitions and of Mr.G.PRABHU RAJADURAI, Advocate for R2, in both the petitions, the court made the following order:-

The petitions are filed to condone the delay of 3704 days in preferring the Civil Miscellaneous Appeals.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the second respondent.
