PRAYER IN S.A. (MD)No.161/2013:

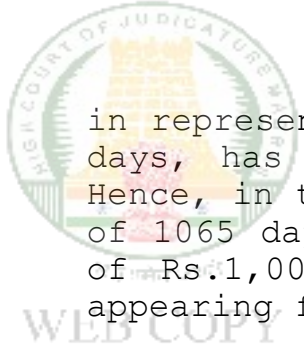
