2.Heard both sides.

3.Initially, at the time of granting anticipatory bail, i.e., on 22.01.2018, this Court directed the petitioners to appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. But, as per the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) that the petitioners are complying with the conditions from 29.01.2018 onwards, i.e., nearly for a period of 18 days only and filed the present petition on 09.02.2018, which is too early. Further, according to the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), charge sheet has not been filed in this case.



4.Considering the nature of offence committed by the petitioners and also considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), this petition is dismissed.
