To extend the time granted in Crl.OP (MD) No.2070/2018 dated 09.02.2018.

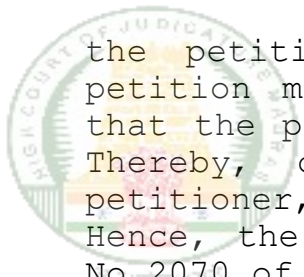
