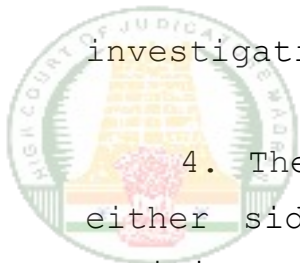

This petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed in CrI.O.P.(MD)No.883 of 2018, dated 19.01.2018.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) submitted that the petitioners had complied the conditions from 27.02.2018 to till date without any deviation. He further submitted that the



investigation is not yet completed.

4. The submissions made by the learned counsels appearing for either side are considered. Previously, at the time of granting anticipatory bail, this Court directed the petitioners to appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., for a period of four weeks only. Now, without completing the above said period, the petitioners herein filed this application to relax the condition. The reasons stated by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners is not justifiable. Hence, this petition is dismissed.
