This Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P(MD)No.17684 of 2017, dated 21.12.2017.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

3.The learned Government Advocate(Criminal side) submitted that the petitioner has complied the condition from 28.12.2017 onwards and investigation is still pending.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) that the investigation is still pending. As per the order of this Court dated 21.12.2017, the petitioner was directed to appear before the respondent Police daily between 10.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. and the petitioner was appeared before the respondent Police from 28.12.2017 onwards. Admittedly, it would appear that



the petitioner was complied with the condition, only for 24 days. Therefore, this Court directs the petitioner to file a petition for relaxation, after completing the condition for one month. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous petition is dismissed.
