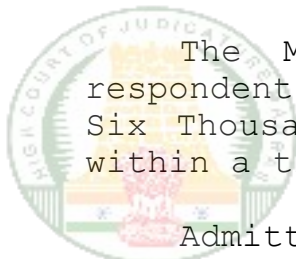
Prayer in WA(MD). 1204/ 2016 :
