PRAYER IN CMA(MD)No.SR40053 OF 2016:-

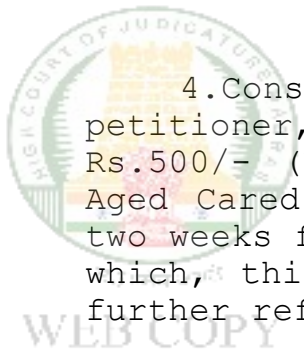
