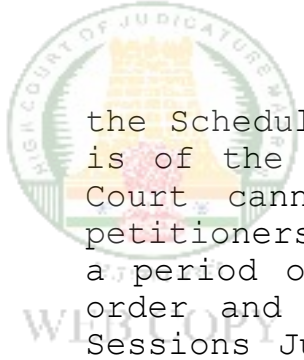
O R D E R

Therefore, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on such surrender, the learned I-Additional District & Sessions Judge (PCR Court), Thanjavur, is directed to consider the bail petition filed by the petitioners in connection with Crime No.18 of 2018, on merits and in accordance with law, after issuing notice to the defacto complainant under Section 15 (A) of the SC/ST Act.

4. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
