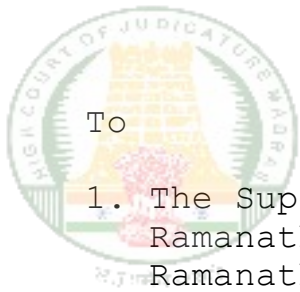
3.Recording the aforesaid submissions, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
