O R D E R

This Criminal Original petition has been filed to direct the second respondent to register a case based on the complaint given by the petitioner dated 02.02.2018.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has borrowed a sum of Rs.20,00,000/- from one Govindaraj, Mari and Rajkumar and that being so, the proposed accused namely, Thirupathy, Manikandan, Thethan and Rajendran have illegally stolen the amount from the petitioner's chit company and hence, the petitioner has lodged a complaint before the second respondent on 12.02.2018, but so far, no action has been taken.
