The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that based on the complaint given by the petitioner, the respondent herein has registered a case on 10.07.2017 in Crime No.27 of 2017 for the offences under Sections 498(A), 323, 406, 506(i) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961. But, thereafter the respondent has not taken any steps for filing final report.
