This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to direct the second respondent to register a case based on the complaint given by the petitioner dated 29.01.2018.

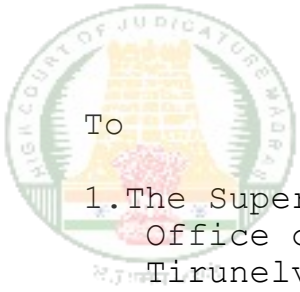
