2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that based on the complaint given by the second respondent, the first respondent has registered a case in Crime No.210/2016 for the offence punishable under Sections 279 and 337 of IPC. He has further submitted that the Motor Vehicle Inspector has clearly stated in his report that the accident was due to mechanical defect and hence, the F.I.R has to be quashed.
