Prayer in CMP(MD). 8565/ 2017 IN CMA(MD)No.SR.20903 of 2017:

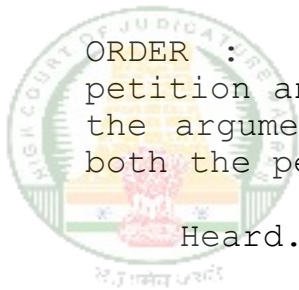
To condone the delay of 223 days in filing the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
