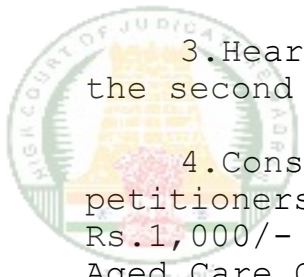
PRAYER IN CMA(MD) No.SR15217 of 2016:
