PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 420, 506(ii) IPC & 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Exorbitant Interest Act 2003 in Crime No.162 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

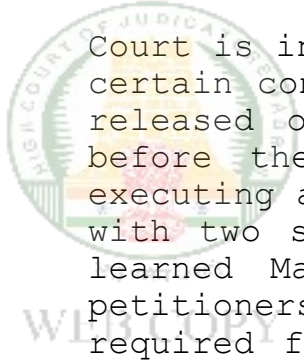
2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners scolded the defacto complainant with filthy language and threatened her with dire consequences due to the defacto complainant's failure to remit certain sums of money said to have been obtained from the petitioners by her.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that no previous case has been registered against the petitioners.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this



Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Valliyoor and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
