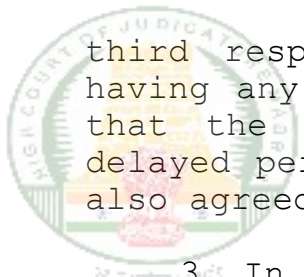
Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to condone the delay of 1337 days in preferring the above appeal.

To set aside the award dated 10.05.2011 passed by the I Additional District Court cum Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Thanjavur in M.C.O.P.No.177 of 2009 so far as it relates to the disability of the appellant and quantum of loss of income and to fix Rs.10,00,000/- towards loss of income in addition to the amount already fixed.
