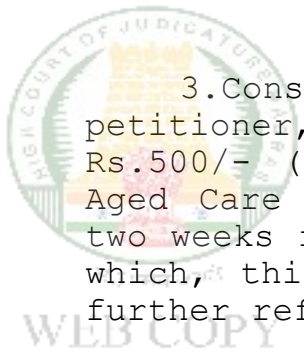
**PRAYER IN CMA(MD)No.SR.55343 of 2015:-**
