O R D E R

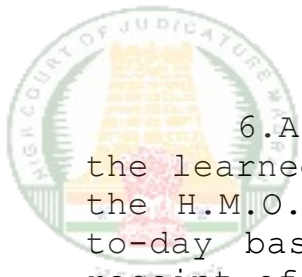

2.The petitioner filed H.M.O.P.No.187 of 2017 before the Principal Sub Court, Trichy for divorce and the same is pending without any progress from the year 2017. In the circumstances, the petitioner has come out with the present Civil Revision Petition for speedy disposal of H.M.O.P.No.187 of 2017.
