PRAYER IN CRL RC (MD) No.SR34324 of 2017:-

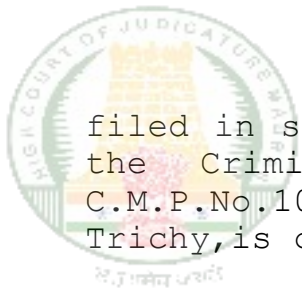
