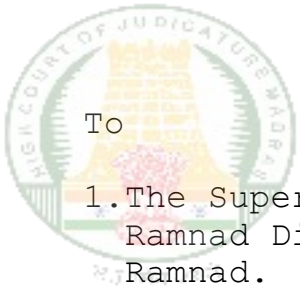
The petitioner has filed this petition seeking production of her daughter and to set her at liberty.
