2.The second respondent police has produced the detenus. On enquiry, the detenu, namely, Pelsia Subashini, informs that she and her child had been thrown out from the matrimonial home and all efforts of conciliation had been rejected by the petitioner. She has now taken up residence with her mother and she and her child are well.



3. Recording such information informed by the detenu, namely, Pelsia Subashini, this Habeas Corpus Petition shall stand closed. Petitioner may work out his rights, if any, in accordance with law.
