This petition has been filed by the petitioner/wife seeking a direction to produce her husband/detenu, namely, Senthil @ Senthilmurugan, aged 32 years before this Court and set him at liberty.

Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the detenu is an accused in many cases and at present in respect of a case in Crime No.129/2018 on the file of the Dindigul South Police Station, for offence under section 379 IPC, the detenu has been arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 26.02.2018.
