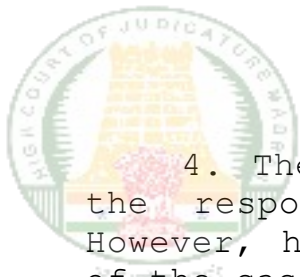

ORDER

This Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed by the petitioner / wife seeking transfer of H.M.O.P.No.979 of 2017, from the file of the Family Court, Madurai to the file of the Family Court, Chennai.

2. It is stated in the petition that the marriage between the petitioner and the respondent was solemnized on 12.02.2014. After marriage, both of them lived happily for some time and they blessed with a male child, now aged about 3 years. Later, due to misunderstanding, the respondent herein / husband of the petitioner has filed H.M.O.P.No.979 of 2017 seeking divorce with the false allegations. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent being a resident of Madurai has filed the above divorce petition at the Family Court, Madurai, whereas the petitioner is residing at Chennai, along with her aged parents and as she is depending upon her aged parents, it is very difficult for her to travel about 460 kms along with her child from Chennai to Madurai for attending each and every hearing of the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner reiterated the averments made in the petition.



4. The learned Counsel for the respondent would submit that the respondent has no objection for transferring the case. However, he prayed for a direction to the Court below to dispose of the case within a stipulated time.

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5. Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned Counsel for the respondent and perused the materials available on record.

6. I am satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in the judgment reported in **2008 (9)SCC 353 (Arti Rani @ Pinki Devi and another Vs. Dharmendra Kumar Gupta)**, has held that convenience of woman is to be taken into consideration first at the time of considering transfer applications. In view of the above and also considering the submission of the learned counsel for the respondent, I am inclined to allow this Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition. Accordingly, this petition is allowed with the following directions:

i) The learned Family Court Judge, Madurai is directed to transmit the entire records in H.M.O.P.No.979 of 2017 to the file of the Family Court Judge, Chennai within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

ii) The learned Family Court Judge, Chennai, after obtaining the records on transfer, is directed to dispose of H.M.O.P.No.979 of 2017 on merits and in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
