3.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) submitted that it is a job racket herein.

Considering the serious nature of the allegation made against the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner got money Rs.3,50,000/-(Rupees Three Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) from the defacto complainant for his son's job, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
