Prayer in WP(MD)No. 290/ 2014 :

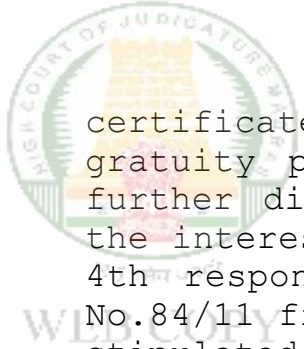
