2.Recording such submission, this petition shall stand closed. No costs.

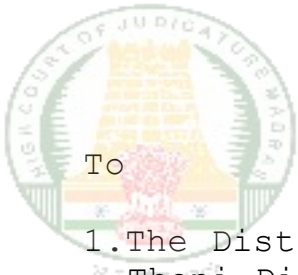
