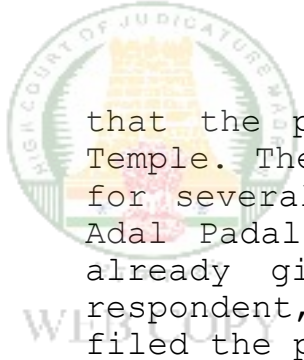
O R D E R

4.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 19.01.2018 and dispose of the same at early by keeping in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of *Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors*, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Cr1.) 233.
