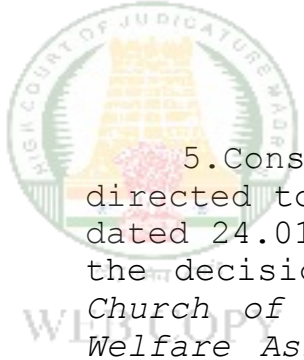
O R D E R

2.Heard, Mr.M.Subashbabu, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.B.Bhagavathi, learned Government Advocate Pleader appearing for the respondent.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is the president of Sports Committee of the said village. The villagers are conducting Kabadi Tournament for several years and this year, they have decided to conduct the Kabadi Tournament on 10.02.2018 9.00 p.m. to 11.02.2018 9.00 a.m. and for that they have already given a representation dated 24.01.2018 to the respondent, but, sofar, no order has been passed.
