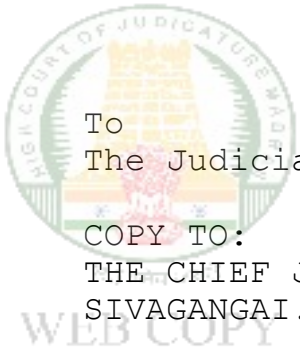
5. In the result, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
