Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to give the permission and adequate police protection for conducting Adal Padal Dance programme on 27.02.2018 in the eve of Temple Ther Thiruvizha Festival in front of Arulmigu Sri. Bhavathi Amman Temple and belongs to Anaikkalpatti, Nagaiyanallur, Kaduvetti, Trichy District on the basis of petitioner's representation dated 19.02.2018.

O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner to direct the respondents to give the permission and adequate police protection for conducting Adal Padal Dance programme on 27.02.2018 in the eve of Temple Ther Thiruvizha Festival in front of Arulmigu Sri. Bhavathi Amman Temple and belongs to Anaikkalpatti, Nagaiyanallur, Kaduvetti, Trichy District on the basis of petitioner representation dated 19.02.2018.

2.Heard Mr.K.Arunraj, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.B.Bhagawathi, learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents.



3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is one of the committee members of the said Temple. The villagers are conducting the "Adal Padal" programme for the past several years and this year, they have decided to conduct the "Adal Padal" programme on 27.02.2018 and for that, they have already given a representation dated 19.02.2018 to the respondents, but so far, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

4.The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 19.02.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the second respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Crl.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
