2.Heard, Mr.J.M.Jaya Karthick, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.N.Shanmuga Selvam, learned Additional Government Pleader, appearing for the respondent.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner and his Village members have decided to conduct cultural event namely Aadalpadal scheduled to be held on



03.03.2018 at night in connection with "Maasi Festival" in Arulmigu Sri Valladikaara Suvami Temple at Mettuvalavu Village, Devathanapatti Post, Periyakulam Taluk, Theni District. Hence, the petitioner gave a representation to the respondents, seeking permission and provide police protection, but, sofar, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.
