3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner and his Village members have decided to conduct the Selection Kabadi Tournament scheduled on 02/03/2018 at 9.00p.m. To 9.00 a.m. for one day held in Kamarajar ground, Panagudi, Tirunelveli District. At the time of passing order, the respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Cr1.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
