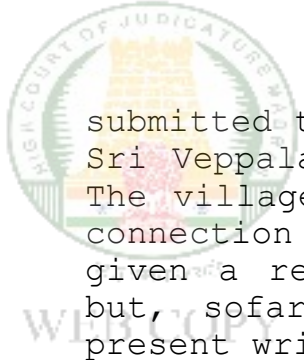
O R D E R

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has



submitted that the petitioner is the member of committee of Arulmigu Sri Veppalai Mariamman Thirukovil, at Goundampatti, Karur District. The villagers are conducting the Adal Padal on 05.03.2018 night in connection with the aforesaid temple and for that, they have already given a representation dated 23.02.2018 to the second respondent, but, sofar, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

4.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 23.02.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of *Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors*, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Crl.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
