ORDER

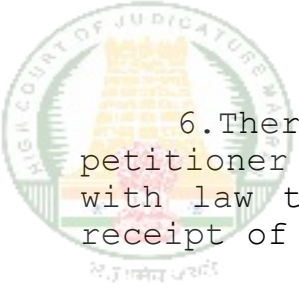
Mr.K.Saravanan, learned Government Advocate, takes notice on behalf of the respondent.
