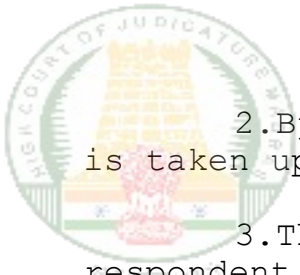

In this regard, he has given a representation dated 25.01.2018 to the respondents herein. The respondents 3 and 4 are directed to consider the writ petitioner's representation dated 25.01.2018 in the light of the aforesaid G.O.(MS).No.61, Transport Department dated 30.04.2016 and pass appropriate orders within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4.The Writ Petition stands disposed of accordingly. No costs.
