The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is the member of committee of



Arulmighu Swami Sree Yematharmarajan Aalayam at Bharathi Nagar, Thiruchitrambalam East, Thiruchitrambalam, Tanjore District. The villagers are conducting the Dance Programme on 09.03.2018 & 10.03.2018 at 06.00 pm., to 10.30 pm., in connection with the aforesaid temple and for that, they have already given a representation dated 02.03.2018 to the second respondent, but, sofar, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

4.The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 02.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the second respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Cr1.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
