ORDER

5. In such circumstances, the petitioner is directed to file fresh application to the second respondent along with all required documents with necessary fees. On receipt of such application, the second respondent is directed to consider the same and pass orders within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above said directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
