PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant advance withdrawal of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) from the Provident Fund bearing Account No.5550 to the petitioner to settle the dues to the Bank for the medical expenses met out by the petitioner to his wife Johnsaraly's cancer disease within a stipulated period that may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

The petitioner is employed in the first respondent corporation as driver. He seeks disbursement of the advance amount from his provident fund. The petitioner's wife is suffering from cancer. Therefore, he submitted an application to the first respondent on 14.12.2017. Till date, it has not been considered.

2.Considering the petitioner's circumstances, the first respondent is directed to disburse the advance amount to the petitioner subject to his eligibility. The petitioner in this writ petition has stated that he is entitled to withdraw a sum of Rs.2,00,000/-. This Court is giving positive direction only regarding the disbursement. As regards the quantum, it would be determined based on the petitioner's eligibility. The writ petition is allowed accordingly. No costs.
