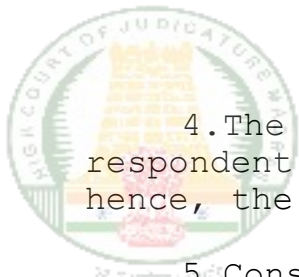

O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed to direct the respondent to grant permission and protection to conduct the 'Adal Padal' dance programme on 28.03.2018 at about 08.00 p.m. to 11.00 a.m. in Arulmigu Muthumariamman Thirukovil, the above said programme is to be conducted at Mukuntha Nadar Street, Andipatti Post and Taluk, Theni District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 16.03.2018.

2.Heard, Mr.C.Bethanasamy, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.N.Shanmuga Selvam, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a committee member of the said village to conduct 'Adal Padal' dance programme every year in Arulmigu Muthumariamman Thirukovil, at Mukuntha Nadar Street, Andipatti Post and Taluk, Theni District. The villagers are conducting the 'Adal Padal' dance programme on 28.03.2018 night at about 08.00 p.m. to 11.00 a.m. in connection with the aforesaid temple and for that, they have already given a representation dated 16.03.2018 to the respondent, but, sofar, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.



4.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 16.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Crl.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
