This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner to direct the respondent to grant permission to perform of cultural programme Aadal Paadal (Isai Nigalchi) to be celebrated on 04.04.2018 at 8.00 p.m., to 11.00 p.m., on the basis of petitioner's representation dated 15.03.2018 in connection with the temple Festival at Arulmigu Sri Raja Narayana Perumal, Ariyanayaki Amman temple Vallambakadu, Aranthangi Taluk, Pudukkottai District.

2.Heard Mr.RMS.Sethuraman, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.N.Shanmuga Selvam, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent.



3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is one of the Villagers of the said Village. The villagers are conducting the Aadal Paadal (Isai Nigalchi) for the past several years and this year, they have decided to conduct the Aadal Paadal (Isai Nigalchi) on 04.04.2018 and for that, they have already given a representation dated 15.03.2018 to the respondent, but so far, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

4.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 15.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Cr1.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
