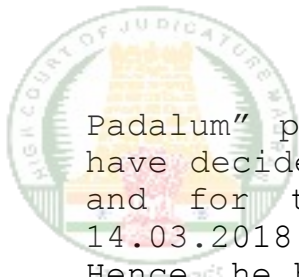

O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner to direct the respondents herein to grant permission and give police protection to conduct the "Adalum Padalum" dance program at about 07.00 pm on 31.03.2018 in pursuance to the festival of "Arulmighu Angala Parameswari Thirukovil" situated in Sundankulam, Vembakkottai Taluk, Virudhunagar District on considering the petitioner's representation dated 14.03.2018.

2.Heard Mr.S.Karthick Subramanian, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.N.Shanmuga Selvam, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is the president of the Festival Organization Committee. The villagers are conducting the "Adalum



Padalum" programme for the past several years and this year, they have decided to conduct the "Adalum Padalum" programme on 31.03.2018 and for that, they have already given a representation dated 14.03.2018 to the respondents, but so far, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

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4. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5. Considering the aforesaid submissions, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 14.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the second respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of **Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors**, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Cr1.) 233.

6. With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
