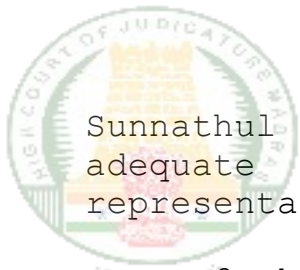

When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 submitted that both parties have appeared before the Revenue Divisional Officer, Melur on 26.04.2018 and given statement that they will give their cooperation to conduct election. He has also produced a copy of the proceedings dated 26.04.2018 in Na.Ka.No.2047/2018/C to that effect, for a perusal of the Court.

3. In view of the said proceedings, it is open to the parties to conduct election, in the light of the proceedings dated 05.07.2017 issued by the Revenue Divisional Officer. If necessary, they can seek police protection before the authorities concerned.
