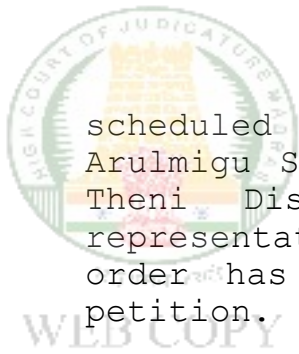

O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed directing the respondents to grant permission and protection for Adal Padal programme perform by "Abithalaya Dance Group" in "Thiruvizha" scheduled to be held on 04.04.2018 at 07.00pm to 11.00pm., at Arulmigu Sri Kaliyamman Thirukovil at Alanthalir, Moolakkadai Post, Theni District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 19.03.2018.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is one of the Committee Members of the said temple. The villagers are conducting 'Adal Padal' for the past several years and this year, they have decided to conduct the 'Adal Padal' programme perform by "Abithalaya Dance Group" in "Thiruvizha"



scheduled to be held on 04.04.2018 at 07.00pm to 11.00pm., at Arulmigu Sri Kaliyamman Thirukovil at Alanthalir, Moolakkadai Post, Theni District and for that, they have already given a representation dated 19.03.2018 to the 2nd respondent, but, sofar, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

4.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 19.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and others, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Cr1.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
