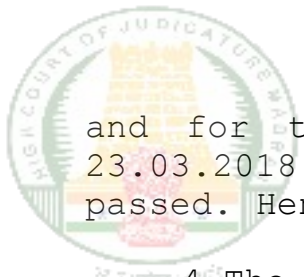

This writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents herein to give permission and necessary protection to perform the cultural programme (ie.,) Dance Programme from 07.04.2018 to 09.04.2018 in the Rama Navami Urchavam festival of Sri Ramar Kovil Hari Bajanaai Madalayam, Aladipatti, Pannaikadu, Dindigul District.

2.Heard, Mr.T.Bashyam, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.B.Bhagawathi, learned Government Advocate, appearing for the respondents.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the villagers are conducting cultural programme every year and this year also, they have decided to conduct the cultural programme (ie.,) Dance Programme from 07.04.2018 to 09.04.2018 in the Rama Navami Urchavam festival of Sri Ramar Kovil Hari Bajanaai Madalayam, Aladipatti, Pannaikadu, Dindigul District



and for that, they have already given a representation dated 23.03.2018 to the respondents, but, so far, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

4. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence, the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5. Considering the aforesaid submissions, the 2nd respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 23.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of **Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and Ors**, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Cr1.) 233.

6. With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
