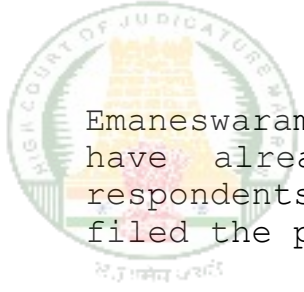

This writ petition has been filed directing the respondents to give permission and police protection for conducting Adal Padal Dance Programme on 02.04.2018 (Monday) night hours for the Yesu Christu Easter Festival situate at Christian Street, Emaneswaram, Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District on the basis of the petitioner's representation dated 21.03.2018.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the villagers are conducting 'Adal Padal' for the past several years and this year, they have decided to conduct Adal Padal Dance Programme on 02.04.2018 (Monday) night hours for the Yesu Christu Easter Festival situate at Christian Street,



Emaneswaram, Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District and for that, they have already given a representation dated 21.03.2018 to the respondents, but, sofar, no order has been passed. Hence, he has filed the present writ petition.

4.The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents has submitted that there is a law and order problem and hence the petitioner's representation is kept pending.

5.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the 2nd respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 21.03.2018 and dispose of the same at early. At the time of passing order, the respondent has to keep in mind the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Church of God (Full Gospel) in India Vs. K.K.R, Majestic Colony Welfare Association and others, reported in 2001 - 1 - L.W. (Crl.) 233.

6.With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
